We support horses through training livery, groundwork, ridden schooling, loading preparation, handling support and behavioural understanding.

Every horse is treated as an individual, with a plan built around their needs, history, confidence and owner goals.

OUR APPROACH

We look at the whole horse.

Behaviour is not viewed in isolation. We consider comfort, confidence, routine, turnout, handling history, management and training foundations.

We do not force quick results.

Progress is built through calm handling, clear boundaries, appropriate schooling, consistent work and owner involvement.

OUR CORE SERVICES

Training Livery

Structured care, training and schooling for horses needing time, consistency and a clear plan.

1:1 Sessions

Private support for groundwork, handling, confidence, communication and day-to-day issues.

Behaviour Support

Whole-horse support for worry, resistance, reactivity, rushing, planting, barging or loss of confidence.

Ridden Schooling

Support for balance, rhythm, confidence, relaxation and clearer ridden foundations.

Loading Support

Step-by-step preparation for trailer or lorry loading without force or flooding.

Yard Visits & Clinics

Group sessions, demonstrations and practical support for yards and owners.

TRAINING LIVERY PACKAGES

Training, schooling and behaviour support for horse and owner

Our training livery packages are designed for horses who need more than a one-off session.

Some horses progress best when their care, handling, turnout, groundwork, schooling and training are managed as one consistent plan.

Each horse receives a bespoke programme based on their needs, history, confidence, behaviour, stage of education and owner goals.

Training livery may include groundwork, ridden schooling, confidence-building, loading preparation, handling support, behavioural work or general education.

Included within the package

Care & routine

Individual paddock, social indoor stable, company at all times, ad-lib hay, basic feed, wood pellet bedding and tailored turnout.

Training & support

Bespoke training and schooling plan, five EQ sessions per week, including one client session, plus daily update videos.

Facilities & welfare

Warm shower facilities, stable disinfection between horses, and support for vets, physios, farriers, hoof boot fitters and other professionals where needed.

1:1 HORSEMANSHIP SESSIONS

Private support for horse and owner

Focused, practical sessions for owners who need help with groundwork, handling, confidence, communication or day-to-day issues.

We assess the horse and handler together, then build clear exercises the owner can continue between sessions.

Sessions are tailored to the individual horse, the owner's goals and the level of support required.

Sessions may include

Groundwork foundations

Leading, backing up, yielding, standing quietly and improving personal space.

Handling support

Helping horses become calmer, clearer and easier to manage during everyday routines.

Confidence building

Supporting nervous horses, worried owners or partnerships that have lost trust.

Owner coaching

Improving timing, body language, consistency and understanding.

Clearer handling. Better communication. Calmer partnerships.

BEHAVIOUR SUPPORT

Understanding the horse before changing the behaviour

Support for horses showing worry, resistance, reactivity, rushing, planting, barging, loading concerns or loss of confidence.

We view behaviour as communication. Before trying to change what the horse is doing, we consider comfort, confidence, handling history, routine, management and training foundations.

Behaviour support is practical, welfare-led and built around clear steps the owner can continue safely.

Support may include

Worry & reactivity

Helping horses respond with more confidence and less tension.

Rushing, planting & barging

Improving clarity, boundaries and handler communication.

Confidence & trust

Building safer responses through calm, consistent handling.

Pain-aware support

Recognising when discomfort may need professional input.

GROUNDWORK & HANDLING

Clearer communication from the ground

Groundwork and handling support helps horses understand pressure, space, boundaries and everyday expectations.

This work can support confidence, manners, leading, standing, yielding, preparation for ridden work and safer daily handling.

We focus on calm, consistent communication that both horse and owner can understand and repeat.

Support may include

Leading & personal space

Improving manners, boundaries and awareness around the handler.

Yielding & body control

Helping the horse move shoulders, quarters and feet with clarity.

Standing & patience

Building calmer responses for everyday handling and routines.

Preparation work

Supporting loading, schooling, vet, farrier and general confidence.

Clear groundwork. Safer handling. Better understanding.

RIDDEN SCHOOLING

Building confidence, balance and clearer ridden foundations

Ridden schooling supports horses who need more confidence, consistency, balance, rhythm or understanding under saddle.

We do not view schooling as separate from groundwork, behaviour or welfare. How a horse moves, responds and copes under saddle can give important information about comfort, confidence and understanding.

Schooling is approached calmly and progressively, with the horse's physical and emotional state kept at the centre of the work.

Support may include

Rhythm & relaxation

Helping the horse work with more calmness, consistency and softness.

Balance & straightness

Supporting clearer movement, better body control and improved foundations.

Confidence under saddle

Helping horses feel safer, clearer and less worried in ridden work.

Owner understanding

Linking groundwork, schooling and handling so progress can continue at home

Calmer schooling. Clearer foundations. More confident horses.

LOADING SUPPORT

Confidence before the ramp

Loading support is for horses who worry, plant, rush, panic, refuse, hesitate or lack confidence around trailers or lorries.

We do not treat loading as just a ramp problem.

Loading begins with groundwork, leading, straightness, stopping, backing up, confidence around pressure and trust in the handler.

Our approach is calm, progressive and based on helping the horse understand the process without force, flooding or panic.

Support may include

Groundwork preparation

Leading, stopping, backing up, straightness and confidence around pressure.

Trailer or lorry confidence

Step-by-step exposure around the ramp, space, sound and movement.

Handler clarity

Improving timing, body language and calm communication.

Owner plan

Clear next steps to continue loading practice safely.

Confidence first. No force. Safer loading.

YOUNG & GREEN HORSE FOUNDATIONS

Giving horses a clear start

Foundation work supports young or green horses who need calm, consistent education from the ground up.

This work helps horses understand handling, pressure, boundaries, confidence, routine and basic expectations before problems become established.

We build progress slowly and clearly, so the horse can learn without being rushed, confused or overwhelmed.

Support may include

Leading & handling

Building polite, confident responses for everyday care and movement.

Pressure & release

Helping the horse understand clear signals without fear or force.

Confidence building

Introducing new experiences calmly and progressively.

Life skills

Preparation for farrier, vet, loading, schooling and general handling.

**Clear foundations. Calm
learning. Confident horses.**

YARD VISITS, CLINICS & SPOOK BUSTERS

Practical support for groups, yards and owners

Yard visits and clinics are designed for owners who want structured, practical learning in a group or yard setting.

These sessions can support groundwork, handling, confidence, loading preparation, young horse foundations, behavioural understanding and owner education.

They are ideal for yards wanting a consistent, welfare-led approach across multiple horses and handlers.

Support may include

Spook Busters

Confidence-building sessions using controlled, progressive exposure to help horses think, process and respond more calmly.

Groundwork clinics

Practical exercises to improve communication, handling and confidence.

Owner education

Helping handlers understand timing, body language, pressure and release.

Yard support

Bespoke sessions for yards, groups, demonstrations or shared learning.

**Shared learning. Braver horses.

PRICING GUIDE

Clear pricing for structured, welfare-led support

Our pricing reflects the time, care, training, travel and preparation involved in supporting each horse and owner properly.

Final pricing is confirmed before booking and may depend on location, session type, number of horses, facilities and level of support required.

Training livery requires a 2-week non-refundable advance payment to secure the space.

All bookings are paid in advance.

Additional costs may apply for specialist feed, supplements, veterinary care, farrier, physio, hoof boot fitting, dentistry, medication, transport or additional services.

TRAVEL, BOOKING & PAYMENT TERMS

Clear terms before work begins

All pricing, travel and booking details are confirmed before a session or livery space is agreed.

We aim to keep everything clear, fair and practical so owners know what is included, what may cost extra, and what is expected before booking.

Bookings are planned around diary space, travel time, facilities, horse needs and the level of support required.

Clear terms. Fair planning. No hidden expectations.

Key Terms

Travel

Travel may be charged depending on location and distance from our base.

Payment

Sessions and block bookings are paid in advance unless agreed otherwise.

Training livery

A 2-week non-refundable advance payment is required to secure a space.

Cancellations

Missed or late-cancelled sessions may still be chargeable.

Departure notice

Training livery requires 2 weeks' notice for departure.

Additional costs

Specialist feed, supplements, veterinary care, farrier, physio, hoof boot fitting, dentistry, medication or transport will be charged separately.

SAFETY, WELFARE & OWNER RESPONSIBILITIES

Honest support with clear boundaries

Horse welfare and safety come first.
We will always work calmly, fairly and
practically, but we will not continue if the
horse, handler, facilities or environment
make the session unsafe.

We do not guarantee instant results.
Progress depends on the horse, owner
consistency, comfort, management and
follow-up work.

Owners remain responsible for their horse,
equipment, facilities, insurance and any
third parties present.

Important Expectations

Horse welfare

Sessions may be paused if the horse
appears lame, unwell, distressed or
uncomfortable.

Professional input

Vet, dental, farrier, physio or saddle-fit
support may be recommended where
needed.

Owner honesty

Previous incidents, known risks, pain history
or dangerous behaviour must be disclosed.

Suitable facilities

A safe working area, suitable equipment and
appropriate handling support may be
required.
